Fight the Flu!

Flu season is upon us! Influenza is a respiratory virus, very different from the “stomach flu.” Symptoms of influenza are fever, cough, sore throat, headache and body aches. The virus is easily spread from person to person through droplets made when people cough, sneeze or talk.

How can you avoid getting the flu? **GET A FLU SHOT!!** The CDC recommends a yearly flu vaccine for everyone ages 6 months and older. The flu shot is nothing compared to how awful you will feel if you get the flu! Avoid the spread of viruses (Influenza, COVID, RSV, etc.) by covering your cough, washing your hands with soap and water after you cough or sneeze and avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.

What to do if you get the flu? **STAY HOME!** At least until your fever has been gone for 24 hours (without medication) and you are feeling better. Please contact the Health Office if your student is diagnosed with influenza, RSV, COVID or strep.
