### **FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK**

**Early Release** – Next Wednesday, December 9, school and childcare will dismiss 2 hours early. **Deephaven's dismissal time will be 12:40 p.m.** and lunch will be served.

**Material Pick Up** - The front doors of the school will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. to pick up classroom materials from the front gym. Your child's teacher would have already notified you if you were to pick up items. Please enter through the office if you arrive between 8:00 a.m. – 2:40 p.m.

**Dismissal will continue to be staggered for students attending Deephaven childcare.**

**Please arrive 5 minutes before your child's dismissal time so we can keep the pickup line moving.**

**Information for parents with a child at Deephaven in our childcare model:**

**Schedule** – Students will be following their regular school schedule. This includes outside recess. Please make sure your child has his/her winter gear each day.

**Change in plans** – Parents with students on site in our childcare model will need to contact the office before 2:00 p.m. if there is a change in the end of day plans. A common example may be that a child is planning on taking the bus home and the parent wants to pick their child up. In these cases, we need to know by 2:00 p.m. or the original plan needs to be followed.

**Communication** should take place with the classroom teacher and NOT the pod para. The pod para will be communicating to the teacher rather than to parents.
