Criteria: All candidates for the Minnetonka Community Education Hall of Fame will be judged on their merits of service, significant and/or long-term contributions to Minnetonka Community Education. They may be previous, active or retired participants, volunteers, employees, or partners of Minnetonka Community Education.

Community Partners who have:

- Demonstrated excellence in partnering with MCE (sponsor, business partner, Individual, MCE Ambassador, etc.)
- Provided opportunities, sponsorship or funding that has allowed community members to participate in programs, or contributed greatly to MCE programs and events
- Gone above and beyond in their community service activities and/or those who have shone a positive light on MCE, it's programs, events volunteers or customers

Participants who have met all of the following criteria:

- Been a strong, consistent voice of advocacy for MCE
- Participated in multiple classes/programs/events
- Participated for a minimum of 10 years as an individual or a family

Individual or family volunteers who have met all of the following criteria:

- Individuals or families who have demonstrated a superior level of volunteer leadership
- Individuals or families who consistently volunteer in multiple programs
- Individuals or families who have made a life time and significant impact with their MCE volunteerism

Minnetonka Staff and MCE Instructors (Retired, Rising Stars, Special Project, Current Staff) who have met all of the following criteria:

- Consistently went above and beyond the requirements and expectations
- Made a significant, consistent and long-lasting community impact
- Demonstrated an unmatched level of personal commitment and unrivaled pride in MCE
- Demonstrated excellence for their work with and for MCE
